The Jon M. and Karen Huntsman Armenian Scholarship Opportunity at Utah State University is available beginning in the Spring 2010 semester to 13 full-time Armenian students seeking an undergraduate degree. Scholarship Provisions

The scholarship program provides for the following:

- International Undergraduate Student Tuition at Utah State University for eight academic semesters.
- Class Fee Allowance for eight academic semesters.
- Book Allowance for eight academic semesters.
- Housing and Meals for eight academic semesters.
- Medical Health Insurance for the duration of the scholarship program.
- One time one-way economy class airfare from Yerevan to Salt Lake City.

Charges incurred by the student at Utah State University beyond the scope of the scholarship program as well as personal expenses are the responsibility of the student.

Eligibility Requirements

- 3.5 GPA equivalent or higher
- Age 17 - 22
 - Military service completed or deferred
- Strong background in leadership and service as well as academics
- English language proficiency at TOEFL 550 score
- Priority will be given to those selecting majors in the basic sciences and technological fields

Applications for this scholarship opportunity will be accepted from **August 3, 2009 through September 11, 2009**. To apply students need to submit the following:

- An online application complete with two 1 page essays. You can download the application form and the essay questions form by clicking on the following links:

- PDF copies of official transcripts for secondary schooling as well as for higher education institutions previously attended. Applicants must submit an official legal English translation complete with notarization for these transcripts.
- PDF copy of the first page of the student's passport.
- Proof of TOEFL or IELTS English Competency test score, if taken.
- Completion of the TOEFL or IELTS is not required at this time in order to be eligible to apply for the scholarship program.

Applications will be reviewed by Utah State University and The Civilitas Foundation. Finalists will be selected and provided with further information related to the scholarship program.
